#### 25/14. Planning

14/01740/FUL – Barn conversion to form new dwelling and conversion of outbuilding to form holiday let. The Parish Council raised the following objections: (i) the increase of the roof line of the barn conversion does not appear to be referenced in the Design Statement and this proposed increase from a two storey building to a three storey building is unsuitable for a green belt location, (ii) similarly the proposed fenestration size and positioning is unsuitable for a green belt location, (iii) the planners need to be mindful that the integration of the built forms are maintained but what is proposed fails to satisfy this relationship. Members of the Parish Council requested that determination of this planning application should be undertaken at a Planning Panel meeting if the planners were minded to approve this application.
